Our school seeks the excellence in all of us, with passion and compassion. We are a community shaped by the pursuit of truth and goodness, providing outstanding preparation for life.



Boarding (Grades 8 to 12)

- 258 students in six houses on campus.
- An urban boarding experience in the safe and friendly city of Victoria, BC.
- International school community with students from more than 25 countries.
- Each room has a private washroom and shower, and is occupied by only two students.
- Three hot meals per day (plus salad bar, soups, cereals and snacks) in the beautiful, modern Graves Hall.
- Shared common rooms have a kitchen, pool tables, TVs and more.
- 6-8 houseparents in each residence to support and care for boarding students.


